

The following criteria have been adopted for US Branch members desiring to advance to the Fellow Grade of The Institution of Fire Engineers:

An applicant must demonstrate successful leadership or outstanding service/contribution to the fire engineering profession over an extended period, not normally less than 15 years, and

Be an existing member of the IFE-USA Branch of the Institution for a minimum of 10 years, and,

Have demonstrated significant individual responsibility, sustained achievement and exceptional professionalism during his/her career. Examples of the type of responsibility, achievement, and exceptional professionalism may include activities such as:

- *Service in a leadership role in a regional, state, national, or international professional organization;*
- *Service in a capacity to develop standards, training resources, or delivering professional development training;*
- *Publication of articles, papers, or research that contributes to the profession, or*
- *Leadership in a local community organization or activity that contributes to the improvement of the overall welfare and safety of the community.*
